Below you will find information regarding P-EBT benefits for the 2020-21 school year.

### **What are P-EBT Benefits?**

- Pandemic Electronic Benefits Transfer (P-EBT) provides food assistance to families with students who would have received free or reduced lunch while attending school but are not in school due to COVID-19 restrictions.
- Families with eligible children will be issued only one card with which they may purchase food. You need to keep this card for the rest of the school year.
- The Indiana Division of Family Resources (DFR) is issuing the P-EBT Benefits.

### **How can I receive P-EBT Benefits?**

- You can receive benefits if your child is eligible to receive free/reduced lunch status for the 2020-21 school year.
- Benefits will be loaded onto a P-EBT card that is sent to you through the mail.
- To receive your benefits, it is very important that Bethel Park Elementary has accurate and up-to-date address information for your children to provide to the Indiana Division of Family Resources.
- Verify your contact and mailing information.

### **When are P-EBT Benefits issued?**

- Benefits are issued quarterly at the end of the month.
- It is important that you keep your card (do not throw it away). If your card is lost please contact 877-768-5098
